## What could Folville do better for your child?

We're not receiving enough communication.	We have a number of different ways that we communicate with parents. We have recognised that these aren't used consistently and as a result not all parents get every message. We have put a separate letter together about the best way to get in touch with us.
The School Website needs updating	The school website has been updated now with the correct information after the change in Head Teacher. IWe have also published term dates for the next three years. If you do want to have any further information please speak to the school office.
Include Halal food in the school meals.	Unfortunately our catering supplier are unable to provided Halal meals. If this situation changes we will let parents know.
The drop off and pick up times between Folville and Imperial are impossible for parents to meet.	We absolutely agree that the time finish times between Imperial Infants and Folville is very difficult for parents. We will be looking at adjusting this in the next academic year. In the meantime if you are struggling to collect your child on time please speak to the school office and we can support you.
More depth and interested in foundation subjects needed.	We are revising our foundation subject curriculum this year to provide more depth and relevant learning for the children. We want children to learn about the areas of the national curriculum that are useful for them and their lives. Over this next year you may see some changes to the learning as we update our curriculum.
Some children can be disruptive in class and on the playground.	We have a new behaviour policy in place and are seeing the difference already. Our children understand our expectations for behaviour and we have seen many improvements since the beginning of the year. We are confident this will keep on getting better. If you have any concerns please see the class teacher so we can resolve this.
